NOTICE OF ELECTION
FOR ORGANIZATION OF
BAYVIEW WATER AND
SEWER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the District Court of the First Judicial
District of the State of Idaho, in and for the County of
Kootenai, has heretofore and on the 4th day of August, 1972,
made and entered its Order calling an election to be held
on the question of the organization of BAYVIEW WATER AND
SEWER DISTRICT, and on the further question of the election
of a Board of five (5) Directors, if said District is organ-
ized, under the provisions of Title 42, Chapter 32 of the
Idaho Code; and

WHEREAS, said Order required the publication of
a Notice of said election;

NOW, THEREFORE, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on
Thursday, the 14th day of September, 1972, between the

hours of 9:00 o'clock a.m. and 6:00 o'clock p.m., an election will be held at the following place: Bayview Chamber of Commerce Building (formerly the Bayview school house), Bayview, Idaho, when and where the qualified electors within the boundaries of the proposed District shall vote on two questions, as follows:

1. The first question to be presented to the voters shall be whether or not such Bayview Water and Sewer District shall be organized.

2. The second question to be presented to the voters shall be the election of five (5) Directors of the District. Nominations have heretofore been made of VERN E. HUBBLE, FRANK W. RUSSELL, WILLIAM G. GREENFIELD, RICHARD J. HANSEN and JAMES MacDONALD, and the ballot shall have provisions for not less than five (5) write-in votes.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that only qualified electors of the District may vote, provided he or she is registered as provided by law. ~~The definition of a qualified elector is as~~

~~follows: A citizen of the United States over the age of 18 years, a resident of the State six (6) months and the county thirty (30) days, both immediately preceding the election.~~

~~Each elector, after taking an Oath that he or she has the qualifications of an elector, shall be permitted to vote.~~

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the boundaries of the proposed district, if approved, will contain the area and lands within said proposed district situate within the County of Kootenai, State of Idaho, the boundaries of which are more

particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on Lake Pend O'Reille on the extended East line of Lot 4, Section 35, Township 54 North, Range 2 West, B.M., Kootenai County, Idaho, 200 feet South of the mean high water line, thence

North along said extended line and the East line of Lot 4 to the North line of the Cape Horn Road; thence

Westerly along said road line to the East line of Lot 2, Section 34 of said township and range; thence

North along said East line to the Northeast corner of Lot 2; thence

West along the North line of Lot 2 and the North line of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 34 to the Northeast corner of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 34; thence

South along the East line of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 580 feet more or less to the North line of the Forest Service Road No. 297; thence

Westerly and Southerly along the North and Westerly line of said road to the North line of Road No. 2 of Sub-district 1 of Lakes Highway District; thence

West along said line to the West line of Section 34; thence

South along said West line to the Southwest corner of Section 34; thence

East along the South line of Section 34 a distance of 1900 feet more or less to the Southerly line of said Road No. 2; thence

Southeasterly along said road line in Sections 3 and 2, Township 53 North, Range 2 West, B.M., to the West line of Lot 2 of Section 2; thence

North along said West line and said line extended to a point in Lake Pend O'Reille which is 200 feet from the mean high water line, measured at right angles to the shore; thence

Northwesterly, Northerly and Easterly along a line which is at all points 200 feet from the mean high water line measured at right angles, 10,100 feet more or less to the point of beginning.



that they are qualified electors within the above described





