



Bayview Water & Sewer District would like to remind customers that only individuals and contractors formally authorized by the District are permitted to represent the District, respond to emergencies, or perform work on District infrastructure.

If someone claims to be acting on behalf of the District and you are unsure of their authorization, please contact the District office before allowing any work to proceed.

The District does not solicit services through third parties without prior notice, nor do we authorize private individuals to independently respond to system emergencies.

Unauthorized representation of the District may create safety risks and could interfere with coordinated emergency response efforts. Any individual found misrepresenting themselves as a District representative may be subject to appropriate action.

Unauthorized Connections and Work on District Infrastructure

Any individual or company found performing work on private property that results in a connection, tap, modification, or interference with District water or sewer infrastructure without prior written authorization from Bayview Water & Sewer District will be reported to the appropriate authorities.

The District will pursue legal action without exception to protect public infrastructure, ensure regulatory compliance, and safeguard the reliability of the utility system. Property owners may also be subject to disconnection of service, recovery of damages, and all costs associated with correcting unauthorized work.

Customers are strongly encouraged to verify that any contractor performing utility-related work has received formal District approval before construction begins.
